## SFF 2019 Post-Trip Activities Guidelines

SFF project activities during the academic year after the summer field trip are essential in achieving SFF Core Ideas. These guidelines are designed to help SFF fellows and teams to better structure, implement and report these activities. Please follow these guidelines and report these activities accordingly.

- 1. Student fellows are expected to engage in the following activities:
  - 1) write SFF project reports
  - 2) make SFF project poster for the ASIANetwork conference
  - 3) make SFF project presentations on and/or off campus
  - 4) work on SFF project final product that is stated in the team project proposal
  - 5) use SFF experience in academic work
  - 6) use SFF experience in co-curricular activities
  - 7) engage in SFF related professional development activities
  - 8) engage in SFF related career or graduate school counseling
  - 9) continue SFF related language studies (when applicable)
- 2. Student fellows are required to meet with faculty mentor(s) at least once every two weeks to discuss the above activities.
- 3. Student fellows are required to report these activities and how these activities have helped them achieve the SFF goals of practical and professional skill development and career and professional preparation in the preliminary and final project reports.
- 4. Student fellows are encouraged to keep a journal of these activities as they occur so they may use the materials in the journal to write their SFF project reports.
- 5. Faculty mentors are required to advise and supervise student fellows on these activities.
